◆ BAPTISM ◆

Parents are expected to be registered and practicing Catholics witnessing to their faith by regular attendance at Mass. Parents should contact the rectory at least three months prior to the desired date of Baptism, in order to allow sufficient time for the sacramental preparation.

◆ FIRST EUCHARIST/RECONCILIATION ◆

Children must be enrolled in the Faith Formation Class *one year prior* to the year of preparation for the Sacrament. In most cases, this sacrament is celebrated in Second Grade.

◆ CONFIRMATION ◆

Children must be enrolled in the Faith Formation Class *one year prior* to the year of preparation for the Sacrament. In most cases, this sacrament is celebrated in Eighth Grade.

◆ MARRIAGE ◆

Engaged couples are to contact the rectory at least six months before the desired date in order to prepare properly for the celebration of the sacrament.

◆ CHILD FAITH FORMATION ◆

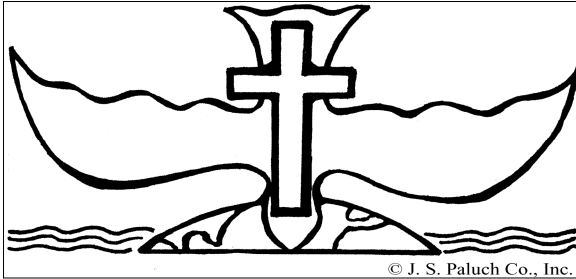

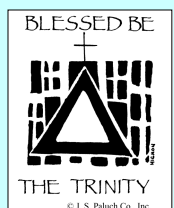

THE RESPONSIBILITY OF OUR FAITH

Today is a day simply to ponder the fact that in baptism we were claimed by God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The first reading from Deuteronomy prompts us to fix in our hearts the truth that God is the Lord of both heaven and earth and there is no other god. Saint Paul reminds us that, because we received the Spirit of adoption in baptism, we are now children of God. In the Gospel, Jesus charges us with the responsibility to make other disciples. LITURGICAL MINISTRY FORMATION

ARE YOU Being CALLED TO BRING THE EUCHARIST TO THE SICK AND HOMEBOUND?
ARE YOU CONSIDERING BECOMING AN EXTRAORDINARY MINISTER OF THE EUCHARIST?
WOULD YOU LIKE TO BECOME A LECTOR?

The Office of Worship offers six hour formation session for new Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and for new Lectors. These formation days are designed to give fundamental information. Participants will be expected to continue their formation by learning the liturgical practices particular to their parish, being publicly commissioned before the parish assembly, and deepening their faith through private and liturgical prayer. In the introductory two hours, new ministers are introduced to sacramental theology, particularly that of the Eucharist. Next, our presenters offer technical and spiritual direction for the minister's specific liturgical role. Finally, new lectors conclude with two hours of coaching in proclamation and oral interpretation. Extraordinary ministers have the option to prepare for bringing the Eucharist to the sick and homebound. Please consider "brushing up" by participating in this workshop if you have been a Lector or an Extraordinary Minister for some time. The programs are held at St. Hilary Church, 761 Hilary Dr., Tiburon, and are on the following days:

New Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion Training: June 13th 9:30 a.m.—3:30 p.m.

New Lector Training: Session I: June 13th 9:30 a.m.—3:30 p.m.

Session II: June 20th 2:30 p.m.—4:30 p.m.
