

Children must be enrolled in the Faith Formation Class *one year prior* to the reception of the Sacrament. In most cases, this sacrament is celebrated in Second Grade.


◆ CONFIRMATION ◆

Dear Friends.

I'm sorry to inform you that all-day adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on First Friday has been cancelled. Everyone wanted to have all-day adoration, but when push came to shove, only a very few people signed up to participate. The new schedule for First Friday is as follows: 8:00 a.m. - Mass; 8:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. - Adoration; 10:30 a.m. - Benediction.

We will be having Soup Supers in the Parish Hall at 6:00 p.m. during the Fridays of Lent, followed by Family Stations of the Cross at 7:00 p.m. in the Church. I hope you can join us. The first Soup Supper and Stations will be this coming Friday, February 19th.

Everyone fourteen years of age and older is bound to abstain from meat on ASH WEDNESDAY, GOOD FRIDAY and the FRIDAYS of Lent.

Everyone eighteen years of age and older, but under the age of sixty, are also bound to fast on ASH WEDNESDAY and GOOD FRIDAY. On these two days, the law of fast allows only one full meal a day, but does not prohibit taking some food during the day, so long as this does not constitute another full meal. Drinking liquids during the day is permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. If you are in doubt concerning fast or abstinence, please call the Rectory Office.

In the spirit of penance, the faithful should not lightly excuse themselves from this obligation.
