◆ RELIGIOUS EDUCATION ◆

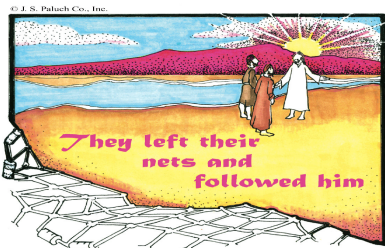

Stained Glass Update

The good news is the stained glass repair is projected to cost much less than the estimates we have been considering. Steve Kalpakoff from The Real Property Support Corporation advised us to go with the option of a protective clear glass wall, rather than the more expensive option of repairing and replacing the existing stained glass. This project will cost the parish roughly \$25,000.00, much less than we had originally anticipated. Steve will contact a glass contractor for an estimate on a protective wall and get back to us.
