◆ RELIGIOUS EDUCATION ◆

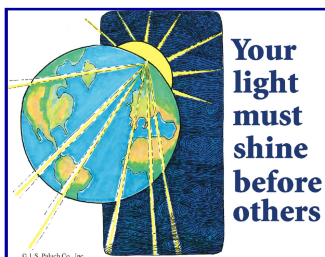
