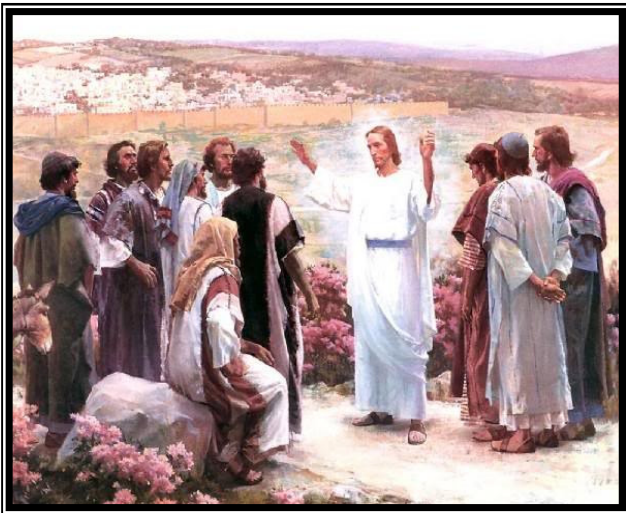

### ◆ BAPTISM ◆

We welcome your child to be baptized at Mater Dolorosa Church. Parents should contact the rectory at least three months prior to the desired date of the baptism, in order to allow sufficient time for the sacramental preparation.

Children must be enrolled in the Faith Formation Class *one year prior* to the year of preparation for the Sacrament. In most cases, this sacrament is celebrated in Second Grade.

### ◆ CONFIRMATION ◆

Children must be enrolled in the Faith Formation Class *one year prior* to the year of preparation for the Sacrament. In most cases, this sacrament is celebrated in Ninth Grade.

### ◆ RELIGIOUS EDUCATION ◆

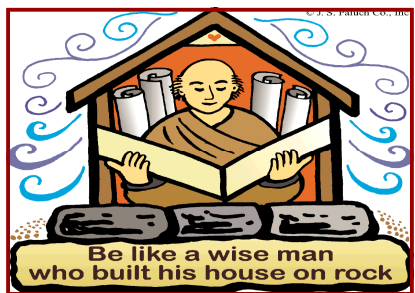

### LENT SEASON AT MATER DOLOROSA

Wednesday, March 9th is Ash Wednesday.  
Mass times are 8:00 a.m.; 12:00 p.m.; and 7:30

p.m. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are universal days of fasting and abstinence in our Church. Fasting means that Catholics 18 to 59 years of age are expected to eat only one full meal and two other, smaller meals, not to equal a full meal. Catholics 14 and older are expected to abstain from meat (beef, poultry & pork) on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays of Lent. Every Friday evening from March 11th to April 15th there will be Soup Suppers and Stations of the Cross sponsored by the various ministries at Mater Dolorosa. On Good Friday, April 22nd, there will be "Living Stations of the Cross" at 1:00 p.m. and 6:30 p.m.
