### ◆ RELIGIOUS EDUCATION ◆

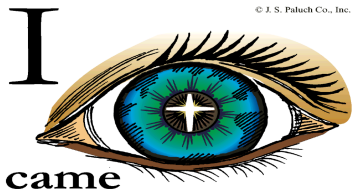
