### ◆ RELIGIOUS EDUCATION ◆

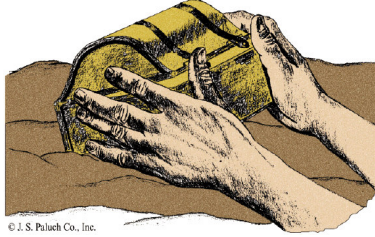

### CONTEMPLATIVE PRAYER and HEALING MASS

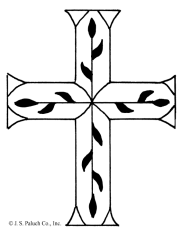
