Children must be enrolled in the Faith Formation Class *one year prior* to the year of preparation for the Sacrament. In most cases, this sacrament is celebrated in Ninth Grade.

◆ MARRIAGE ◆

Please contact the Rectory Office at least *6 months prior* to your wedding date to allow time for Marriage Preparation.

◆ RELIGIOUS EDUCATION ◆

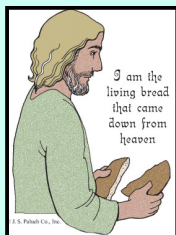
THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST CORPUS CHRISTI

For the third year, the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops (USCCB) has asked us to pray and fast for 14 days (a fortnight) for freedom. The opening Mass is Saturday, 6/21 at 5 p.m. After Mass, the movie *A Man for All Seasons* will be shown; the following Saturday after the 5 p.m. Mass we will watch *Scarlett & Black*. Each of the 14 days will include Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and praying the Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Religious freedom is a precious gift from God.
