◆ MARRIAGE ◆

Please contact the Rectory Office at least 6 months prior to your wedding date to allow time for Marriage Preparation.

SAVORING THE EXPERIENCE

One of the wonderful things about vacations is the time we spend two or three weeks afterward savoring the experience, sharing vacation photos and memories with our family and friends. This kind of reflection puts us back in touch with the original experience and reminds us of the relaxation and wonder the vacation afforded us. Today, on the Third Sunday of Easter, the Church blesses us with reminders of what we celebrated two Sundays ago. All three readings are reflections on the meaning of the death and resurrection of Christ. One of the threads running through these reflections is that the purpose of the Lord's suffering, death, and resurrection was to save us, to forgive our sins. We are given fifty days to ponder this reality—fifty days to savor the experience of Christ's dying and rising for us.



CHILD FAITH FORMATION

Thank you to all who supported our First Communion Family Retreat. A special thank you to Fr. Angel and Deacon Romeo, who led our families in a reflection of the presence of Christ in the Eucharist and its importance in our life. Early registration for Faith formation classes will begin May 1st thru June 15th. Take advantage of the early enrollment incentive; register your child by June 15th. Classes for next school year 2015-16 will begin on Sept 15th. First Communion families: There is a mandatory practice for the celebration of the Sacrament of First Communion on Tuesday, April 21st, from 4:30pm to 6:00pm in the school and church. First Communion students will attend their regular classes as well as the practice.

Questions of the Week:

In today's Gospel reading, two disciples who had just met the risen Jesus on the road are telling their story to the other disciples. Then right in the middle of their story, Jesus appears and says, "Peace be with you." The frightened disciples think they are seeing a ghost. Jesus has to show them his wounds and even eat a piece of fish to prove that he is real. The good news is so good that the disciples find it hard to believe at first.

Levels 1-6: *Why do you think Jesus comes back to his friends and brings them peace? What work does Jesus give his friends to do?*

Level 7 & Confirmation classes: *The two disciples who met Jesus on the road to Emmaus also did not recognize Jesus until they shared a meal with him. How does the gospel say they came to know him? How do we know him in that same way?*
