## LOVE ONE ANOTHER

Last Sunday we heard the familiar passage from John's Gospel in which Jesus uses the metaphor of the vine and the branches. In that passage we were told that if we remained in Christ we would bear much fruit. Today's Gospel tells us just what that fruit is: love. Today's second reading and Gospel together create a great hymn to love. The chorus of this hymn is simple—God loves us so much that Jesus was sent into the world so that we would have life. The Lord Jesus, who last week told us to remain in him, this week tells us to remain in his love. In a world marked by division and terrorism, the Lord's final words in today's Gospel are a great challenge: "This I command you: love one another."

## LIVING ROSARY

### May 17th, after the 12:00 noon Mass

Please join the Faith Formation students and families in praying the Living Rosary on Sunday, May 17 after the 12noon Mass. A "living" Rosary is essentially prayed in the same way as a "regular" Rosary. Rather than sitting in pews, each individual facing the altar and holding his or her own beads, forms the Rosary with their bodies. Each person will represent a bead in the decade and lead the prayer for that bead. The intention for this rosary is for the missionary effort of the Church in the five continents, which is also known as the World Mission Rosary and was introduced by Archbishop Fulton Sheen in 1951. This rosary honors the work of mission, our call to be missionaries, and world unity and peace through its special emphasis on each of the continents, where prayers are needed and our brothers and sisters in Christ live and play and pray just like each of us! The rosary is a traditional form of prayer, which combines remembrance, praise and petition. It remembers the events of Salvation History and is in fact the memorial of Christ's mission. The World Mission Rosary, reminds us through prayer, of our responsibility to share the Good News with all the Nations. EVERYONE is INVITED to COME and PRAY with US!
