**What is one thing that you can commit to do this week that shows your love of God and neighbor?**

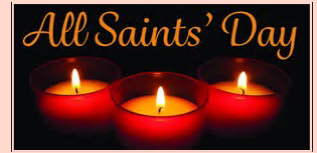
#### Annual Volunteer Appreciation Dinner Saturday, November 18th at 6:00 p.m.
