Children must be enrolled in the Faith Formation Class one year prior to the year of preparation for the Sacrament. In most cases, this sacrament is celebrated in Ninth Grade.

◆ MARRIAGE ◆

Please contact the Rectory Office at least 6 months prior to your wedding date to allow time for Marriage Preparation.

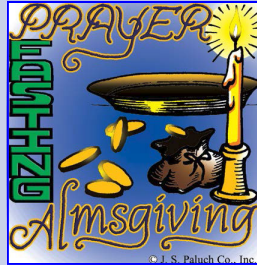
The First Sunday of LENT

Deuteronomy 26:4-10; Psalm: 91;
Romans 10:8-13; Luke 4:1-13

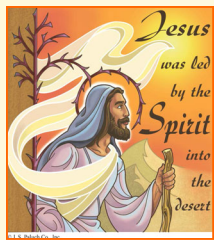
ALMSGIVING, PRAYER, FASTING, AND TEMPTATION

As we begin our season of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving, the reading from Deuteronomy reminds us of our duty of almsgiving, that we “set [our offerings] before the Lord, [our] God, [and] shall bow down in [God’s] presence” (Deuteronomy 26:10). The reading from Romans refers us to our prayer, reminding us that “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart . . . For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved” (Romans 10:8, 13).



These are comforting words, and encourage us to ask God for what we need and to aid us in our prayer. Finally, the Gospel of Luke shows us a fasting Jesus, who was tempted as we are, and who knows what it means to be human. Someone once said that temptation arises when you’re tired and weary, and the devil comes along and makes a perfectly reasonable suggestion. CHILD FAITH FORMATION



Family Prayer is a wonderful and rewarding activity. Finding time and the opportunity is not always easy. For the next few weeks we will offer ideas/tips to help bring your family together in prayer. Last week we focused the Daily Examen. This week we will focus on praying with everyday prompts. Using everyday sights as prayer prompts is a simple way to weave more prayer into our day. For instance, when you are stopped at a traffic light,

tell God thank you for a blessing, or when you see an ambulance drive by with it's lights on pray for the healing of the person being cared for. For questions about a CFF activity or event or our CFF program, please come by and visit the CFF office or call/email.

Examen

How To Pray:

- Set aside some quiet time at the end of the day.
- Ask for God's presence in your prayer time.
- Thank God for the day's blessings.
- Ask the Holy Spirit for guidance.
- Go over the events of the day, looking for 2 positive and 2 negative aspects. Imagine you are reviewing your day with Jesus. Talk to him about your reactions and emotions during the day.
- Reconcile and resolve - give thanks, apologize, ask for guidance to do better tomorrow.

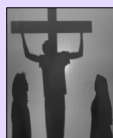
