◆ BAPTISM ◆

We welcome your child to be baptized at Mater Dolorosa Church. Parents should contact the rectory at least *three months prior* to the desired date of the baptism, in order to allow sufficient time for the sacramental preparation.

◆ FIRST EUCHARIST/RECONCILIATION ◆

Children must be enrolled in the Faith Formation Class one year prior to the year of preparation for the Sacrament. In most cases, this sacrament is celebrated in Second Grade.

◆ CONFIRMATION ◆

Children must be enrolled in the Faith Formation Class one year prior to the year of preparation for the Sacrament. In most cases, this sacrament is celebrated in Ninth Grade.

◆ MARRIAGE ◆

Please contact the Rectory Office at least 6 months prior to your wedding date to allow time for Marriage Preparation.

◆ RELIGIOUS EDUCATION ◆

Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

June 30, 2019

1 Kings 19:16b, 19-21; Psalm: 16;
Galatians 5:1, 13-18; Luke 9:51-62

RADICAL TRANSFORMATION

On this Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, the readings describe anything but an ordinary time. They are disturbing and they leave us disturbed. The Old Testament reading recounts a young man's radical break with the past to follow a new path. The Gospel describes how life as we know it is abruptly changed if we follow the call of Christ. The psalm and Paul assure us that such life-altering change is possible only because of the power of God's love. We are presented with a stark choice. To love as God loves, we must leave our old lives behind. We must leave behind not just the bad, the selfish, and the evil but the ordinary, our daily work, and the important, our families, our lives. 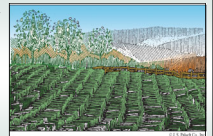

CHILD FAITH FORMATION

Simple ways to encourage family prayer this summer! "Parents who pray together teach by the way they live that God is real; that he is present, listening, and eager to be a part of our lives" (Archbishop Charles Chaput). Try these ideas to add more family prayer. Make the Sign of the Cross upon waking. Let this be the first prayer you each say every day. Pray the Angelus at 6:00am, 12 noon, 6:00pm, when you are together. This happy prayer reminds us of Jesus' birth. (There is an app for this too!) Invite him to join you. Light a candle at each family gathering to represent Christ, our family guest. Teach prayerful listening. Write down children's prayer intentions on a calendar and monitor the results. How prayer is answered teaches us about ways God communicates. Turn the car into a chapel. Use the drive to the grocery store, to practices, or play dates for family prayer, to sing favorite hymns, listen to sacred music, or count blessings together. Develop spontaneous prayer skills. We have such a rich treasure of Catholic prayer that we forget to pray spontaneously. Encourage children to pray unrehearsed and detailed prayers aloud to build a lifelong habit. Practice acceptance. It is important for children to learn early that while what we want may be compelling, what God wants for us counts most. Besides, God's ideas are always better than ours. – bought to you by Partners in Faith, Helping Our Children Grow in their Catholic Faith.

Do you have a 1st grader or 8th grader in your home? Now is the time to consider enrolling your incoming 1st grader for the sacrament of First Communion or your 8th Grader for the sacrament of Confirmation. Please note there is a two year preparation requirement for the sacrament of First Communion and Confirmation. All NEW and RETURNING students must register for the new faith formation year. The devotion consists of these 4 points:

- ◆ Confession (8 days before or after the first Saturday)
- ◆ Attend Mass and receive Holy Communion
- ◆ Rosary
- ◆ 15 minute meditation on the 20 Holy Mysteries

Most important in our First Saturday devotions is the fervor with which we perform them, specifically as acts of reparation for sins against the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Our Lady of Fatima summed up the motive of all of her apparitions and requests with these poignant words: "So numerous are the souls which the justice of God condemns for sins committed against me, that I come to ask for reparation." This is the very heart of the First Saturday devotions.
