◆ MARRIAGE ◆

Please contact the Parish Center at least 6 months prior to your wedding date to allow time for Marriage Preparation.

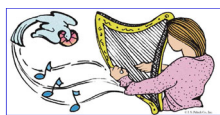

Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Malachi 3:19-20a; Psalm: 98;
2 Thessalonians 3:7-12; Luke 21:5-19

In this week's Gospel reading, Jesus speaks of scary things—wars, famines, persecution, plagues, earthquakes, and signs falling from the skies. Yet in the midst of his warnings about the judgment coming on earth and the persecution his followers will face, Jesus exhorts his disciples, "By your perseverance you will secure your lives." Perseverance is the key. Jesus will always strengthen and comfort those who persevere in faith. And we can rest in this same hope today. Just as the early Christians persevered in times of trial, so too are we called to persevere in the daily crosses the world might inflict upon Christ's followers today. We all are called to die to ourselves in many little ways each day through the sacrifices we make for our faith and by persevering through the misunderstanding, ridicule, and even hostility we might face for remaining faithful to Christ in our secular world today.

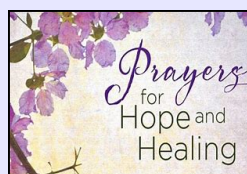
