The Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Isaiah 49:3, 5-6; Psalm 40;
1 Corinthians 1:1-3; John 1:29-34

Today's Gospel reading sheds light on the meaning of some words we hear every time we go to Mass— words we might take for granted or not fully appreciate. Sometimes we hear things so often, we no longer listen to what the words really mean. When we say the words Lamb of God, during Mass, we are directly quoting John the Baptist. One day, as he sees Jesus, he cries out, "Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world!" John was a great leader, but he recognized that he was not the center of the movement he had begun. He was the forerunner; the voice in the desert. By calling Jesus the "Lamb of God," John sums up his entire mission: he is to prepare the way for the One who will come, John recognizes Jesus as the Savior and exhorts us to do the same.

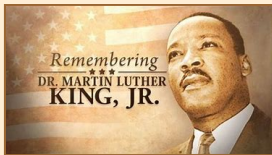

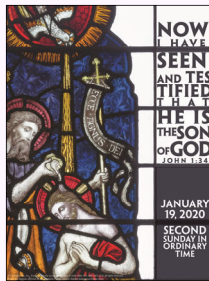
TODAY'S READINGS
