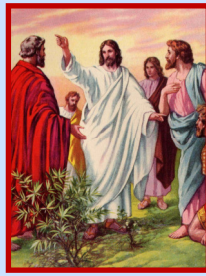

GOD CHOSE US

Who chose first, God or you? That is the question explored in today's three readings. The second reading, from Paul's Letter to the Ephesians, reads almost like a hymn. It praises God for choosing us, for calling us to serve, and for blessing us in our service. Paul makes it clear how honored we are and how special is the call to live as children of God. This is through no doing of our own.

The first reading and the Gospel use prose rather than poetry to describe the same truth: God did the choosing, not us. When the prophet Amos was berated for being a prophet, he retorted that the whole thing wasn't his idea in the first place. Neither did the twelve apostles in today's Gospel ask for their calling. Jesus sent them forth, two by two, to do the work of his kingdom.

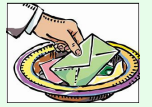

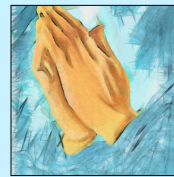

Mass Guidelines at Mater Dolorosa Church

The following modifications are outlined according to what is to be retained, what is to be dropped, what may be restored, and what is to be modified. **Most significantly, it is now time to return back to Mass.** Therefore, the dispensation for the Sunday obligation was rescinded on June 24, 2021. That is, the dispensation for attending Sunday Mass will be dropped, and the Sunday Mass obligation restored.



To be Retained:

▫ Doors and windows are to stay open to ensure maximum ventilation, weather providing. ▫ Congregants are to wear masks during Mass indoors (unless they have a physical or personal difficulty with it). ▫ Churches should continue to maintain visible signage encouraging social distancing of six feet, and washing of hands and maintaining hygienic protocols. ▫ Hand sanitizers are to be readily available. Collections may be taken up by baskets at the back of the church or the vestibule. ▫ Missal to be placed on a stand at the presider's chair. ▫ No procession with the offerings to the altar. ▫ Location of vessels on the altar according to the current protocols. ▫ Sign of Peace to be exchanged by the people reverently bowing to those near them. ▫ The current procedure for the distribution of Communion is to continue (don mask, sanitize hands, sanitize again if make contact). ▫ Distribution of Communion under the species of bread only. Parishioners who are not currently receiving Holy Communion may approach a priest or deacon for a blessing. Holy water in stoups at entrances to the church will not yet be available.

To be Dropped:

▫ Dispensation from Sunday obligation (This does not apply to those persons restricted from coming to Mass for health reasons, or health concerns). ▫ Contact information lists and consent forms, as well as taking of temperatures. ▫ Sanitizing pews and other-high touch areas before services. ▫ Wearing of masks for outdoor services. ▫ Washing of purified vessels with hot water and soap after Mass.

To be Restored:

▫ Use of missals, bulletins, hymnals, cards, worship aids will be available in the vestibule. A bulletin will be handed to you by an usher. Families may take home a missal and bring it to Mass with them. ▫ The resumption of pre-Covid 19 Mass schedule in parishes. ▫

To be Modified:

▫ Social distancing reduced to six feet between households. ▫ An organist and a cantor is allowed, keeping a minimum of twelve feet apart from each other. ▫ Congregational singing (presuming that, when indoors, the people are wearing masks). ▫ Liturgical ministers do not wear masks while carrying out their liturgical ministry (including cantor at the ambo, provided the closest person is at least twenty feet away). ▫ Concelebrating priests do not wear masks unless they cannot remain a minimum of six feet apart from each other.

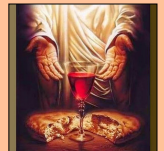

FAITH FORMATION at MATER DOLOROSA

Faith formation is a lifelong journey. It's about being formed to live our faith. We do that by "echoing the Word of God" in our lives. Aside from preparation for the Sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation, our ongoing faith formation programs nurture each child's growth in their baptismal faith from Grades 1- High School (as long as the child is under 18 years old). We encourage all families with children and teens to give them the opportunity to grow in their faith by enrolling in our new Faith Formation year 2021-2022. FEAST OF FAITH Invitation to the Eucharistic Prayer



After the presider washes his hands, he turns to the people and says, "Pray that our sacrifice may be acceptable to God the almighty Father." We have brought forward bread and wine, and now we are asked to see in these simple gifts upon the altar a sacrifice offered to God. Our response is rich in theological meaning. "May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands." The words point to the unique role of the priest, whose hands, at his ordination, were anointed for just this purpose: that he might "sanctify the Christian people and offer sacrifice to God" (Rite of Ordination). We ask God to accept our sacrifice not because it is worthy of God, but simply "for the praise and glory of his name." God does not need our offering, but allows us to give it so that we might grow in holiness. And God, never to be outdone in generosity, gives all that we have given back to us, "for our good and the good of all his Church." This Mass benefits not just those who have gathered, but, in the mysterious economy of grace, the whole Church. In the words of Saint Paul, when one part rejoices, the whole body "shares its joy".
