### WHAT IS CHILD FAITH FORMATION?

Child Faith Formation is not just about education. It is about a life-long process of being formed to live our faith and ongoing conversion. We do that by "echoing the Word of God" in our lives.

Aside from preparation for the Sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation, our continuing religious education classes nurture each child's growth in their baptismal faith from Grades 1 to 12.

#### WHAT IS REQUIRED?

Required first and foremost is a desire to learn more about your faith. The family is invited to be registered parishioners at Catholic Mater Dolorosa Church. Preparation for the Sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation is a two year process. Children must attend both years of classes to receive the Sacraments. Parents whose child is to receive their First Communion or Confirmation must provide a copy of their child's Baptismal. Reconciliation and Communion Certificates at the time of registration.
